The Future Of Finishing is Global And You Can Catch it in Vegas Next!

We also got to host over 30 of our vendors and coating partners all in one place. Our customers got to see the "Future of Finishing" in action, and they were raving about it! They even asked us to do it again!

Next up, we headed to Monterey, Mexico, to exhibit at FAB-TECH Mexico the following week with our Total Finishing Systems crew. Then, two weeks later, we left for Germany where TFS joined our partners who were exhibiting at LIGNA, the world's largest woodworking exhibition. We're always the first to research and bring back new technologies from all these trips, and this one was no exception.

VD Finishing was exhibiting a new technology called "Ghost" at Ligna. They can print QR codes on coated parts that are both visible and invisible. This means that large-scale production customers don't need to print labels with sticky adhesive on their parts. The adhesive can be a sticky mess later on, and it can even get lost in the process. With Ghost, we print a visible QR code on the front of the part (like a cabinet door, for example). Then, the operator scans the QR and loads the part. They paint the back side of the door in flatline, knowing that the printed label on the front will be painted over in the next step. We then print an invisible QR code on the now-finished backside and complete the painting process on the front of the part. The now-invisible unique QR code can be seen by holding a black light. This means it can be seen for years to come, even after it's installed in someone's home. So, if there's a warranty issue, the cabinet manufacturer can scan the invisible QR code and get all sorts of data, like the date it was painted, the color, the time, the temperature, the operator who painted it, the coating, and even the batch number of the coating. All of this data can be fed into the VD MODUS 4.0 System

that they developed and released two years ago at the last LIGNA show. It's pretty impressive and really solves a unique problem!

Guess what? We've got an exciting new solution for filling knot holes in wood, and we're thrilled to share it with you! We'll be launching this live at the AWFS show in Las Vegas, from July 22nd to the 25th.Come on over to our booth and check out this incredible process that can fill and paint a knot hole in less than 60 seconds! Tech Tips by Tony

Are You Cross-Threading Your Gun Parts Without Realizing It?

Cross-threading can cause serious, often irreversible damage to your spray gun components. Proper technique during reassembly is critical to maintaining the performance and longevity of your equipment.

What to Watch For:

- Unusual resistance: If threads begin to tighten after only 1-2 turns by hand, stop immediately.
- **Misalignment:** Starting a part at an angle is a common cause of cross-threading.
- Contamination: Dirt, overspray, or Debris in threads can cause binding and lead to damage.

Best Practices to Prevent Cross-Threading:

- Always start threading by hand, not with tools.
- Ensure all threads are clean and free of debris before reassembly.
- Use a light lubricant if needed, but avoid over-lubrication.
- Thread components in straight and level- never force a fit.
- If resistance is felt, back out and recheck alignment.

Pro Moves:

- Use a thread chaser periodically to clean and maintain internal threads.
- Inspect threads with a magnifier under good lighting- look for burrs or wear.
- Label or photograph complex assemblies before disassembly to ensure accurate reassembly.
- Keep a clean workspace to minimize contamination.

Taking the extra time to reassemble with care helps avoid costly repairs and keeps your equipment running like new.


