**SUR-REPLY OF RESIDUAL
BENEFICIARY CHARLES A. HAROLD,
JR. IN RESPONSE TO PETITIONER'S
REPLY (DKT #33)**

Respondent and Residual Beneficiary Charles A. Harold, Jr.
("Respondent"), responds to the Petitioner's Reply (Dkt #33) to Respondents'
Verified Joint Objection (Dkt #28) as follows:

Respondent was served with the Verified Petition for Approval of Interim
Account; For Discharge of Successor Trustee; and For Appointment of Successor
Trustee (Dkt #1) on or about December 8, 2022, along with a document entitled
"Amended Notice of Court Date." On page 3 of the Amended Notice, it states:

RESPONSE: If you do not agree with the motion, you must file a
response. Your response **must be in writing** and must be delivered
no later than four (4) court days (not including court holidays) before
the court date. The person who scheduled the court date can reply,
in writing, to the response. The reply is due two (2) court days prior
to the hearing.

1 Therefore, pursuant to the instructions on the Amended Notice, Respondents'
2 response was due on Monday, January 30, 2023, which is four court days before the
3 hearing on Friday, February 3, 2023.

4 If counsel for Trustee wanted the response filed on January 26, 2023, he should
5 have given such instructions. Those are not the instructions provided to Respondent.

6 Respondent opposes the motion to continue the February 3 hearing and
7 requests the court to proceed on the merits.
