- I, Charles A. Harold, Jr. declare as follows:
- 1. I am a Residual Beneficiary of the Sharon M. Harold Irrevocable Trust dated November 12, 2004 ("Trust"). I also have power of attorney for Sharon M. Harold along with my sister Amy Jane Small, and we are attorneys-in-fact for her as well. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein. I make this declaration in support of the Opposition to Motion for Partial Summary Judgment on Trustee's Entitlement to Employ Counsel on Behalf of Trust and Pay Counsel from Trust Funds.
- In preparation for this Opposition, I reviewed Paice's Accounting of Trust.
 My review also included examining the bank records of Grantor.
- 3. On Schedule J of Paice's 2010 accounting, submitted by David Llewellyn, there was an entry by Paice that stated: "3/29/10 CASHIERS Sharon Harold Distribution (Note 1) \$8,000." At the bottom of the Schedule J page there was a note

from Trustee which read, "Note 1 Documentation for cashier's check for \$8,000 on 3/29/10 is pending."

- 4. I reviewed Grantor's bank records for that time period and found a deposit in Grantor's USAA bank account for \$2,000 on 4/1/2010, one day after the \$8,000 cashier's check was issued to Grantor.
- 5. I then reviewed other bank records given to me by Grantor right after the TEDRA petition was filed. I obtained them during a trip to Grantor's home in approximately January 2023.
- 6. I located a copy of the \$2,000 cashier's check issued by BECU to Grantor on 3/29/2010, the same day the \$8,000 cashier check was issued according to Paice's 2010 Schedule J.
- 7. To date, Grantor nor I have received any explanation or documentation from Paice per his Note 1 on Schedule J.
- 8. I contacted David Llewelyn and asked why Paice's Accounting of Trust showed a cashier check for \$8,000 that was actually a cashier check for \$2,000. On September 19, 2023, I asked Llewelyn to verify if this meant the accounting was \$6,000 short, which meant that the Trust was missing \$6,000. He said he has received no back-up documentation from Paice, so he cannot verify the discrepancy without further tracing.
- 9. I compiled the documents I reviewed and highlighted my findings in yellow so the reader can trace the money through the various stages of banking. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is a true and correct copy of the documents I reviewed.
- 10. I reviewed Gail Mautner's profile page on the Lane Powell website and found that she had written an *amicus curiae* brief in the *Jones* case cited in the Opposition. I also discovered that she is an expert in TEDRA law and teaches WSBA CLE classes on this and other subjects. Attached hereto as Exhibit 2 is a true and correct copy of the profile page I printed out from LanePowell.com found at https://www.lanepowell.com/Our-People/Gail-E-Mautner.






