

# Reissuance of Temporary Protection Order and Notice of Hearing

- 1. The Temporary Order for Protection and Hearing Notice issued on March 6, 2023 (hereafter, "Temporary Order") is hereby extended through the new court hearing date on this matter on April 20, 2023 at 10:30 AM at King County Superior Court, Kent Courthouse via Zoom. See **How to Attend** at the end of this order.
- The Order to Surrender and Prohibit Weapons issued on (date) \_\_\_\_\_\_\_
  is hereby extended through the new court hearing date listed above.
- 3. [X] Other:
  - 1. Any and all pleadings to be considered by the Court in connection with the hearing on April 20, 2023 shall be filed with the Court no later than April 17, 2023; David Paice shall file any additional pleadings in opposition to be filed on April 14, 2023, and Charles Harold's pleadings in reply to new opposition pleadings, if any, to be filed on April 17, 2023.
    - 2. The Temporary Order issued on March 6, 2023 is MODIFIED as follows:
  - **a.** Effective immediately upon entry of this Order, the portion of the Temporary Order blocking David A. Paice's personal checking account is VACATED and David A. Paice's personal BECU account ending in x-2739 is unblocked and unfrozen in all respects.
  - **b.** Effective immediately upon entry of this Order, the portion of the Temporary Order blocking the BECU account ending in x-9307 in the name of Sharon M. Harold Irrevocable Trust dated November 12, 2004 ("Harold Trust") is VACATED and BECU account ending in x-9307, which is held in the name of the Harold Trust, is unblocked and unfrozen in all respects.

- 3. Except as modified above, the Temporary Order shall reissue and remain in effect until the hearing on April 20, 2023.
- 4. Upon unblocking and unfreezing of the Harold Trust's BECU account ending in x-9307, the Trustee shall re-distribute \$20,740.50 to Ms. Sharon M. Harold. The distribution of \$20,740.50 to Ms. Harold may be made via wire or via check. If the distribution is made via check, then it will be sent to Ms. Harold via overnight courier with an anticipated delivery date of the following day.

#### Joining by Computer or Smartphone

Zoom hearings can be joined from the internet, the Zoom application ("App"), landline or mobile phone (Instructions below), and with a H.323 or SIP device.

You will need the Zoom Meeting ID number for the hearing. The Zoom Meeting ID for your calendar can be found on the first page of this Notice and on the court's website.

- 2.Once on the Zoom site and click the "Joina meeting" option, or use this link: <a href="https://zoom.us/join">https://zoom.us/join</a>
- 3.Enter the Meeting ID and click "Join"

- 4.Once you have joined, you will enter the virtual waiting room. Prior to the start of your hearing, the judicial officer or court employee will admit you into the virtual hearing. You might have to wait past the start of your hearing time. Please be patient.
- 5.If you know which courtroom your hearing is in you can self-select following the below instructions. Click the **Breakout Rooms** option in your

meeting controls.



This will display the list of virtual courtrooms. Click Join next to the virtual courtroom you wish participant in, then confirm by clicking Join again.
