- Reduce the risk of cross-contamination from outside food.
- Ensure safe food preparation — all meals are prepared, cut, and served in line with strict food safety standards.
- Save valuable educator time by avoiding the need to cut and prepare food brought from home, allowing staff to focus fully on caring for and supporting the children.
- Offer inclusive, balanced, and nutritious menus that support growth, energy, and development.
