By continuing to use our website, or by accepting cookies through our cookie banner, you agree to our use of cookies in line with this policy, except where you have disabled them through your browser or cookie preferences.

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help websites function properly, improve user experience, remember preferences, and provide information about how visitors use the site.

Cookies may be session cookies, which are deleted when you close your browser, or persistent cookies, which remain on your device for a set period or until deleted.

2. How we use cookies

We use cookies and similar technologies to make our website work properly, help keep the website secure, understand how visitors use our website, improve website performance and user experience, and remember your cookie preferences.

3. Types of cookies we may use

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of the website. They enable core functions such as page navigation, security, form handling, and saving your cookie preferences. Without these cookies, the website may not function correctly.

Analytics and performance cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with the website, such as which pages are visited most often and how users move around the site. This information is aggregated and used to help us improve the website.

Functional cookies

These cookies may be used to remember choices you make, such as your preferences, to provide a more personalised experience.

Security cookies / third-party protection tools

Some parts of the website may use third-party security tools, including Google reCAPTCHA, to help prevent spam and abuse when forms are submitted.

4. Google reCAPTCHA

Our website contact form is protected by Google reCAPTCHA. This helps us distinguish between genuine users and automated or abusive activity.

reCAPTCHA may place cookies or collect information such as your IP address, browser and device information, user interaction data, time spent on the site, mouse movements, or other behavioural signals.

This processing is subject to Google's own privacy terms and policies.

5. Cookie consent

When you first visit our website, you may be shown a cookie notice or banner. This allows you to accept cookies used on the site.

You can also control or delete cookies through your browser settings at any time.

Please note that disabling some cookies may affect how the website functions.

6. Managing cookies

Most web browsers allow you to manage cookies through their settings. You can usually view what cookies are stored, delete cookies, block all cookies, block cookies from specific websites, or clear cookies when you close your browser.

To manage cookies, visit your browser's settings or help section.

7. Third-party cookies

We may use third-party services on our website from time to time. These third parties may set cookies where their services are active on our site.

These may include services used for spam prevention and security, analytics, embedded content, or website functionality.

We do not control third-party cookies directly. You should refer to the relevant third party's own privacy and cookie policies for more information.
