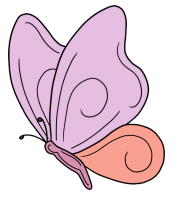




# ACE SPRING NEWSLETTER

# ACE PROGRAM INFO

## Eligibility

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must be able to independently feed oneself
- Must be able to take medications independently
- Participants must have a current OR542 contract with Good2Go

## Participation Fees

- This is the actual cost to participate in the community activity. This cost may include such things as tickets, entrance fees, food/beverage, tips, etc. The participant must cover these costs themselves, as they are not covered by state funding agencies.
- Participation fees are normally paid to the vendor/venue of the event
- On rare occasions, Good2Go will purchase tickets or materials for an event in advance and be reimbursed by members
- Advanced purchased tickets are **non-refundable**
- Good2Go participants must be able to carry and handle their own money. Good2Go staff can assist with and monitor financial transactions, but are not allowed under any circumstances to handle member money

## No-Shows

- Individuals who no-show for events will be contacted by phone to confirm attendance or absence
- Individuals who no call, now show three times will be suspended from participation for six months

## Tipping

- Tipping a minimum of 15% is required when participating in ACE events that include meals that are provided by a server
- Good2Go staff can assist in calculating tips as needed

## Enrollment

- Event enrollment can be done through the Good2Go website (g2gooregon.com)
- The ACE program does not accept call in or drop in enrollment
- Participation fees are not collected at the time of enrollment
- Enrollment is required Tuesday the week before the event

## Transportation

- Rules do not allow for any funding for transportation during ACE events
- Members are expected to make arrangements for transportation to/from the venue or HUBs
- This may include parents, public transit, or 1:1 staff previously scheduled prior/after the event
- When scheduling transportation, please make sure pick up is within 15 minutes of events end time
- Individuals will be billed 1:1 time for staff support while waiting for rides more than 30 minutes after the events posted time

## Cancellations

- Cancellations should be made at least a week in advance of ACE events
- If a member cancels more than three events in a month with less than a week notice it may lead to temporary suspension of events
- Please call the ACE program manager for cancellations within 24 hours of the event. Two cancellations with a less than 24 hour notice may lead to temporary suspension from events.
- Cancellation penalties do not apply to cancellations related to ice, medical reasons, employment, or emergencies
- See full cancellation policy in the ACE Participant Handbook

## Termination

- Good2Go wants to ensure the positive experience for all of its members. As such, there are occasions where participants may be asked not to participate in future activities. The following reasons may result in termination from the ACE program:
- Physical assault on another individual during an event
- Not treating others with respect through language or actions (See full value contract in ACE Participant Handbook)
- Having 3 no-call no-shows for events
- Repeatedly not having necessary funds for participation fees
- Any action or choice that places the member or other members at risk of personal harm
- Not following participation guidelines as outlined in the ACE Participant Handbook

## Group vs 1:1 Hours

- Individuals wishing to participate in the ACE Program must have group support hours in their Individual Support Plan (ISP) and Service Agreement. These services are titled Day Support Activities and are under the OR-542 contract with the state
- You must request these hours be included in your ISP before participating in ACE events
- Individuals requiring individual personal support must receive approval for the OR-542 RC code from their case manager

## THE BASE OF A.C.E.

- All participant **MUST** have OR 542 in their ISP or service agreement to participate. Call your case manager!

- Activities are limited to contracted members. Others may not attend. This includes family members, significant others, PSWs or providers from other agencies.

- Members **MUST** pay for their own participation fees. DHS rules do not allow G2G to fund these cost for members.

- Tipping is required when dining out on ACE Activities.
  - Having fun is mandatory!

- We are Good-2-Go...Are You?

Enrollment is required by Tuesday, the week prior to the day of the event to insure proper staffing ratio for member safety.


## How to Enroll

1. Go to [www.g2gooregon.com](http://www.g2gooregon.com) ( must use computer , does not work on phone)
2. Click the "ACE" button on the right side of the top banner.
3. Click the " ACE Event Sign Up" button located half way down the page.
4. Follow the steps listed to create an account if you do not have one. Click the "become member" button .
  - Use a unique email address as your username ( it cannot be staff's email)
  - Create Password you will remember and write it down somewhere safe.
5. Once an account is made click "**Back to Home**" then "**Members Log In**"
6. Register for events through the "**Browse Events**" button or "**Calendar**" Button
7. Once registered, view and cancel events under " My Events" button .
