JUROR: Eric Buris will be the juror for this year's show. Eric has been making things out of metal and teaching others how to do the same for over twenty years. He has an MFA in Metals & Jewelry from Arizona State University. Since then, he's been employed as a bench jeweler, an adjunct instructor at multiple colleges, and participated in fine art and craft shows throughout the United States. He is currently the Metals Studio Coordinator at Pocosin Arts School of Fine Crafts in Columbia, North Carolina. He spends his off time with his printmaker partner, Gretchen and their dogs Javier & Oscar.

DATES: Exhibit dates September 1 to September 28.

Opening reception is Thursday, September 3, 5:30 – 7:00 p.m.

ENTRY FEE: Current PAL members may submit up to two works for 2D or 3D, or one of each, for \$35. Fee is non-refundable. Members don't need to be juried in the gallery to participate.

ACCEPTABLE WORKS: Your *original* works in any media are acceptable. These must *not* have been previously exhibited at PAL and should have been completed within the last two years. Wall art is limited to 1,298 sq. inches.

SUBMISSION OF WORKS: Works should be brought to the PAL Gallery, 133 N. Church St. in Hertford on Thursday, August 27 & Friday August 28, 2 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., or Saturday, August 29, 11:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Please complete registration form and labels, and affix labels to the back of your work. Artists should call (252-426-3041) to set up an appointment. **No work will be accepted after August 29 at 2:30 p.m.**

PREPARATION OF WORKS: 2-Dimensional work must be **framed and wired** for hanging. *NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS* will be accepted. Gallery-wrapped canvases will also be accepted as long as the sides are finished as part of the painting or photograph and the piece is wired for hanging.

RETURN OF WORKS: Artists should arrange to pick up their work Tues., September 29, 2 – 4:30 p.m.

SALES: PAL will retain a 30% consignment fee on all works sold. Please include this when pricing work. Any pieces that are sold should remain until the close of the exhibit. Exceptions may be made if the purchaser is not local.

AWARDS: PAL encourages artists to submit their best and most innovative pieces in consideration for one of the following awards:

Best in Show, \$250

2 – Best of Category (2D/3D), \$100 each

4 – Honorable Mention Ribbons
