Allendale has one of the highest Cub Scout participation rates in northern New Jersey and has been recognized with the Journey to Excellence Gold Award (top 10%) given to packs for outstanding programming. We have over 120 youth and 30 adult volunteers in our Pack.

The Cub Scouts program aims to prepare youth to grow into self-reliant and dependable adults. Cub Scouts achieve this with a lineup of hands-on activities and adventures focused on:

Research has shown a number of benefits for kids involved in Cub Scouts. Below are some of the findings with a link to the various articles.

- Scouting helps build character. In a Tufts study, Cub Scouts became significantly more cheerful, helpful, kind, obedient, trustworthy and hopeful about their future than non-Scouts (article link).
- Scouts are more likely to earn "mostly A's" in school compared to non-scouts (article link).
- Scouting closes "soft-skills gaps" and builds leadership/teamwork capabilities (article link).
- "Youth who participate in Scouting and youth sports are more likely to embrace prosocial values such as 'helping others' or 'doing the right thing' than youth who only play sports." Many Scouts in our Pack play multiple sports along with other activities and are still able to participate in Cub Scouts (article link).
- Adults who were Scouts are more likely than those who have never been Scouts to have higher levels of education, have higher earnings, and to own their own homes (<u>article link</u>).

Don't like to camp? Camping trips are optional. Some families come for the day activities and campfire, then head home to sleep. Other "camping" trips include winter camping in cabins or sleeping on cots inside the Intrepid or Liberty Science Center.

With the uncertainties of the impact of COVID-19 on future activities, the Pack Committee has been meeting to identify the best way to continue the Scouting program in a manner that reduces risk, reduces screen time/virtual meetings, and increases outdoor activities. For Pack activities, we are planning for all events to be outdoors with social distancing. These plans may change as guidelines are updated. Each Den will also put together plans to complete adventures in a way that reduces risk. Families will be free to decide which activities they wish to participate in.

Dens are a group of children from the same grade that meet together to work on age appropriate activities. Dens meet about once a month. The Pack is the combination of all the Dens together. Pack meetings are once per month with other optional activities available, such as camping/hiking/etc.

While <u>Cub Scouts</u> now welcomes all children, please note that <u>Girl Scouts</u> is a separate organization. We have several girls that participate in both Girl Scouts and Cub Scouts.
