- Michael Barcadepone, Superintendent
 - o NJSLA
 - Biggest advice he can give parents please treat it like another week/test/quiz
 - Be cognizant of how you engage your kids with the testing
 - We are a high performing district so usually always do well
 - Brookside project
 - Coming along well now, did have a delay
 - Planning to have a fun opening event for students
 - Sushi/Barbeque
 - Hillside project
 - Received final plans
 - Will be ready to break ground as soon as students go on summer break
 - Hillside Tree concern
 - A tree recently came down in the back of the school in areas of wet lands
 - 2 trees have fallen in past 14 days
 - Has been talking to DEP
 - Have an arborist coming today to evaluate area and trees
 - Need permission to remove dead trees
 - Has received permission to cut trees down, cannot remove root of tree, cannot use crane (cannot touch the ground)
 - Next Board Meeting
 - Will be adjusting last day of school since have not used all emergency days
 - Last day of school will be June 19th
 - Jenny Mario asked a question
 - If last day changes, will 8th grade graduation change?
 - Mr. Winkelstein responded

- If last day changes, may change 8th grade graduation, but will only happen if there is enough time to notify parents of change
- June 19th is a federal holiday, so graduation can only be on 18th or 20th
- Bruce Winkelstein, Brookside Principal
 - Last sprint towards end of the year
 - Book fair next week
 - 8th grade set up to help K and 1st graders
 - Will have about 7-8 older students per a group to help younger students
 - Brookside going Monday and Thursday and Hillside going Tuesday and Wednesday
 - Thinking ahead to next year
 - Will be meeting with 5th-8th graders to go over their schedule, decisions they have to make and what things look like going forward
 - 5th graders will be deciding their electives
 - Music class vs. band vs. band and chorus
 - 7th graders decide their electives
 - Digital media vs band vs. band and chorus
 - 8th graders have a lot of electives to select from
 - Will also be discussing how 8th grade impacts high school
 - Incoming 4th graders
 - 3rd grade teachers help to make 4th grade classes, then Mr.
 Winkelstein assigns them teachers
 - Trying to diversify classes as much as possible
 - Will be same process for incoming 5th graders
 - Requests for next year
 - None taken for teachers. If there is a situation where an older sibling had a teacher and you do not want that teacher, they will try to accommodate if possible
 - If there are students your child needs to be separated from, again will do their best to separate if possible
 - State testing coming up
 - Will send out notifications closer to date
 - Information for parents
 - NJSLA not a sole determinant for students
 - Results used for high school placement
 - Start looking from 7th grade onward for math and science placement
 - Goal is to do the best they can
 - Use the scores to determine how school is doing collectively to ensure our program is as strong as it could be
 - Field days and field trips coming up
 - Will get calendar out for all events
 - 8th grade graduation
 - Tuesday, June 18th
