- Allendale Police Department
 - Special guests for today
 - Officer Alex Helmer
 - 8th year as a police officer in Allendale
 - Today discussing pedestrian safety
 - Especially important during school hours in am and pm
 - Walk at a cross walk- look left, then right, then left again
 - Make yourself visible, make eye contact with driver
 - Don't look at your phone, be alert and aware
 - Always walk against traffic if no sidewalk
 - If a sidewalk can walk in same direction as traffic
 - Always use a cross guard (8-9am and 3-4pm present)
 - Don't cross between parked cars on main street
 - Huge safety hazard
 - Use cross walks
 - Make sure kids being mindful of driveways
 - Illuminated signs at Crestwood and downtown area- please cross at these locations
 - At night, try to cross where there is a light or traffic light so you can be seen
 - Question
 - How do we ask for another crossing guard? Requesting one at George Street
 - Would need to be brought up at a Town Council Meeting or Supervisor of Police Department
 - Lights also not flashing at school signal
 - County has to come out- will bring to their attention
 - Ms. Maroulis joined discussion
 - Don't let you kids walk into traffic in parking lot
 - Not as much visibility with big cars
 - Parking at a premium and always a lot of cars
 - Drop off line going well
 - Please don't double park or block people in
 - There will be an assembly with AAA where students will learn and practice pedestrian safety
 - Question regarding the Protocol for Front of Hillside
 - Hillside street backs up as people are trying to get into parking lot in the morning, people park over cross walks
 - Worried about being safety and being late
 - Ms. Maroulis responded:
 - Usually happens at 8:40am or after
 - Ms. Maroulis and Chief Dillon will be out there next few days to help with traffic and set protocols for drop off at beginning of year
 - Back of hillside runs well with cars and drop off
