 Treasurer's Report- We have \$29,908.54 in operating account and a little over \$200 in CheddarUp to be transferred over

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

- Michael Barcadepone, Superintendent
 - We are interviewing for staff for next year
 - We are in the process of redoing our website and students are helping.
 This will go live for September and we are looking for programs to streamline communication with families.
 - Parents received emails about eligibility for the summer program, please reply to accept.
 - Our district is writing a grant to AFEE. Originally the grant was being focused on redoing the cafeteria area but this is being swapped to redoing the stages/auditoriums in both schools. This will include replacing the complete audio/visual systems at both schools to be used in many ways,
 - There has been a lot of discussion about the 8th grade standards on diversity/inclusion- we will have a presentation for parents at night to talk about the standards set out by the DOE, plus what are the laws of what must be included.
 - We will also have 3 breakout sessions to focus on types of lessons and how we incorporate them, multiple perspectives, and how we evaluate resources. This is educational plus parent involvement.
 - The meeting will be iin end of May/early June
 - Next Wednesday at 7pm will be the district's annual budget presentation.
- Bruce Winkelstein, Brookside Principal
 - o There's a lot going on right now!
 - Battle of the Books on Thursday 4th graders in AM, 5/6 in in the PM and for those kids and their parents
 - LinkIt Testing- we are in the third round. We had the whole school yesterday and Friday will be the second day. This will give us information on which areas we need to focus on.
 - The spring Book Fair is next week

- 5th grade parents got an email with a survey for field trips next year, specifically the Disney trip, only 50% of parents replied please submit reply if you haven't. We need more information before deciding if this trip can happen.
- Will meet with all the 5/6/7th graders in early May to talk about their scheduling for next year.
 - 6th- We will discuss elective choices and how their schedule looks
 - 7th- We will discuss elective choice and math placement impact going forward
 - 8th- There are 13-14 electives to choose from, and then we will start talking about high school
 - Emails to follow and with the link to the curriculum guide
- May 16th NJ SLA- 9 full days of testing depending on your grade levelscores used for HS placement or for identifying concerns and strengths.

 - o The 1-3 graders will be eating outside again soon
 - Preschool parents have been notified if they got into the preschool program
 - Kindergarten groupings letters are going out on Monday
 - For incoming K students, there will be a visitation in small groups to meet with academic support teachers for a baseline screening
 - This will identify kids who need extra support and to identify kids for the summer program
 - The final round of LinkIt assessment is coming up in grades 1-3 in ELA and math
 - The spring Book Fair is next week
 - This Thursday or Friday a notice will be going out to 1st grade parentsthere will be a mobile food lab on site to do Stem activities to learn about food and sustainability
 - May 2nd is Theater week- 79 second and third graders are participating and the final performance will be on that Friday at Brookside School. There will be no in school dress rehearsal.
 - We are working with 3rd grade parents on the end of year activities. The end of year celebration will be a carnival theme on June 16/17. Ms Maroulis will meet with PE teachers for the school-wide field day.
 - The concert is on June 3 for Grades 1-3
 - Brookside orientation information will be coming out soon for May 25th
 - Christina- We will touch base about Alex's lemonade stand, possibly on June 3rd

- International Day is coming up. The display by Mrs. Knowlton is great. We are submitting a grant for International day through AFEE for the performance.
