 - Playground
 - Hopefully children are enjoying it
 - Few items need to be completed still
 - Need gate by circle
 - Cutting some pipes to make it safer
 - Games to be drawn out on blacktop in next week or so
 - Brookside
 - E-sports
 - Next Thursday when kids are off, final day for set up for E-Sports
 - 3 categories
 - Games, sports, things to play
 - Competitive gaming
 - E-sports team to compete against other schools
 - Can get scholarships from these teams
 - Lounge area
 - Area for kids to relax
 - Will be putting in a bigger arcade game into this area
 - This will have games that the kids have coded themselves
 - They will get to play each others games
 - Creating a nexus between E-Sports, the technology club and this new machine
 - Also will have a broadcasting station

- Will be able to announce and work on their public speaking as well
- Work on Brookside and Hillside is getting recognized by other schools
 - Architect getting asked about outside lunch area for kids

 - Librarian at Hillside and Brookside
 - Heads student council and runs BTV shows
 - Love to bring students from both schools together, like we did for playground

Guest Speakers

- APD
 - Officer John Rubino
 - Grew up in this town
 - Was an EMT and Fire Chief
 - Want to talk about School safety
 - Officer Layng first line of defense
 - Class 3 officer, SLEO
 - Retired officer at each school
 - Trained at very high standards for active shooter situation
 - Within 2 minutes we can be at any school in town
 - Mrs. Maroulis commented
 - We practice a monthly fire drill and lock down drill
 - Sometimes kids do pull fire alarm
 - Please talk to your kids about this
 - Officer David Warbrick
 - Started here one month ago
 - Police officer for 7.5 years
 - Some complaints about passing stopped school buses, trying to stop illegal uturns as well
 - School Officer Peter Layng
 - All around the school
 - Please also come to me with questions/concerns
 - Detective Rosado
 - Been here for 9 months
 - Officers are walking schools every day
 - Trying to normalize uniforms for kids
 - Is dealing with a lot of juvenile behaviors right now
 - Please be mindful of where your kids are, who they are hanging out with

- Pedestrian safety discussed and dealing with animals and their droppings
- Question Kids afraid to walk because of bear, are there any safety protocols?
 - Detective Rosado voluntarily deals with black bears
 - There is a system that they communicate with school about bear
 - 3 categories to black bear
 - Cubs
 - Go in opposite direction if you see the cubs
 - Scared of noise
 - Clap loud or yell and bear should move away from you
 - Always move slow
 - Not a normal functioning bear
- O Question Is the program for special needs kids still being run?
 - Blue card given to kids from the state
 - Supposed to present it to law enforcement if there is ever any engagement
 - Working to get it completely implemented in Allendale
 - All officers are trained to deal with special needs kids as well
- Question If you need to call police will they know about special needs kid in home?
 - Said your address shows up and get information about meds, special needs etc
- Question Are kids who are misbehaving younger or older?
 - Not specific to any age group
- Talk to kids about how law enforcement acts in different situations
- Ms. Maroulis commented
 - Parents grateful for crossing guard at George Street
- Hillary DeVincenzo, Youth Service Librarian
 - New person in Library Ms. Anna
 - There on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday
 - Will help kids to start love reading
