

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING SPENDING AUTHORITY TO THE WATER SUPERVISOR FOR VILLAGE OF CENTERTOWN, MISSOURI IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERTOWN MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: If emergency maintenance is needed to preserve Village property and to maintain continuous water service to the Villagers of Centertown, the Village of Centertown, Missouri, hereby grants to the Water Supervisor for the Village emergency spending authority up to Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) contingent upon the following conditions. The Water Supervisor must first attempt to contact at least two (2) of the Trustees of the Village of Centertown to notify them of the emergency and get approval for the necessary repairs. If the Water Supervisor is unable to reach the Trustees, he is authorized to use his spending authority to make the repairs he deems necessary in an emergency. He shall notify the Village in writing of any expenditures made immediately.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and approval.
