ORDINANCE NO. 126

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12.60 OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERTOWN CODE REGARDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERTOWN, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 12.60 of the Village Code of the Village of Centertown, Missouri, regarding penalties for violation of the village's animal control ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the existing text and substituting the following text:
 - 12.60 <u>PENALTIES</u> Generally. Any person violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof may be fined in the sum of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and/or a sentence of imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days.
- Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and approval.
