Upcoming Shoots in the month of June, 2024!

6/09/2024 - Nostalgic Military Shoot! This will be the one and only military shoot of the year. Sign in starts at 10:30 am. Shooting starts at 11:00am. This is competition for rifles designed from the Korean war and older. This includes the SKS, M1 Garand & Carbine, Mosin-Nagant, SVT, FN-49, SMLE, K98, M1A/M14, and many more! Iron sights only. Not sure if your rifle qualifies?

There will be 4 divisions that all run back to back:

1st - 100 yards, any rifle you like.

2nd - 100 yards, carbines only.

3rd - 250 yards, Bolt Action only.

4th - 250 yards, Semi-Auto only.

You are encouraged to shoot in all 4!

PROCEDURE: You vs. a randomly chosen opponent, first to hit and knock over 3 plates will win. Everyone will shoot against 5 other people for each division entered in. All shooting will take place at shown yardage, from off hand, or a bench rest, depending on the round. Minimum round count 25 rounds per division. Bring plenty! (Plate size is about 12"x14"). Break out the old milsurp and come on down.

6/23/2024 - Pin Shoot. Singletary will be hosting the 2nd pin shoots this year! Shoot distances will be 7-15 yards. 5 to 10 bowling pin targets. Targets will be shot off the table. Each round won will add another target to your next round up. Perfect for new shooters and seasoned pros. Come give it a try! Includes Rimfire and Centerfire competitions run back to back. Registration opens at 8:30am, first shots at 9:00am.
