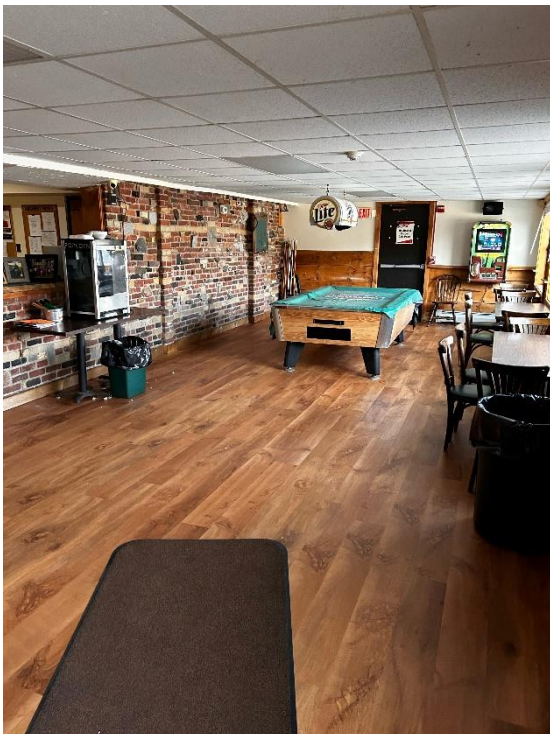


## Archery News
