At our last General Assembly Meeting in June, I proposed a few items which I've laid out below. As a club, we have seen an increase in costs including, but not limited, to insurance, taxes, and utilities.

As such, the Board of Directors has agreed to propose the following:

- Regular Membership increase to \$175 (this rate is competitive to many local clubs including, but not limited to: Nipmuc, Uxbridge Rod and Gun, Century Sportsman, 200 Sportsman's Club)
- Senior Membership increase to \$100
- Increase in New Membership hours from 6 to 10 hours
- Allow buy-back of New Membership hours at \$20 per hour (this would be new and a great option to hold New Members
 accountable for their volunteer hours at renewal time
