Pursuit of Excellence (Violet Newby) - January 27th meeting.

Violet and Marcus Newby attended the GSQA POE classes in 2010. Now Violet is sharing what she learned with us!

Date: January 27, 2011 – regular meeting date, time and place.

We will be doing Four Patch Triangles, Buzz Saw, Buzz Saw Pinwheels, and Faux Delectable Mountains. Violet will also describe the amounts needed for each project individually at the meeting, but thinks it best to have everyone bring a scrappy assortment of lights and darks, since all of these blocks lend themselves well to a scrappy appearance.

It will be necessary to bring a sewing machine, a rotary cutter and mat (at least a few of us), scissors, and some irons. There should be at least a cutter, mat and iron for every two or three people present.


