QUILTING TIPS

- 1. To see what a medium or large print fabric will look like when it's cut into smaller pieces, make a template window out of paperboard, such as an empty cereal or cracker box. Then take it with you when you are fabric shopping or auditioning fabric.
- 2. Use plain water only when washing out water soluble marker pens from your fabric, and hand wash well, as detergents and ironing may set the ink permanently.
- 3. Use tracing paper for paper piecing. It is much easier to see through and tear away than freezer or typing paper.
- 4. Keep a supply of half-square triangles by your sewing machine and use them instead of scraps of fabric when you are starting or ending your sewing. No unsightly threads all over and you have a lot of half-square triangles to make a quilt with.
