Calendar Quilt Instead of Monthly Lotto Block

Ida M as the Guild's new Vice President put forth a motion that instead of making the Monthly Lotto Blocks as in the past, the Guild membership should make a Calendar Quilt. Each month a quilter will make a block that reflects the month of the Business Meeting. The block size, pattern, fabric, etc. is chosen by the guilter. The 12-block guilt must be completed for the 2025 Quilt Show. Ida discussed with Sue C to have an area for Viewer's Choice on the Calendar Quilts.

When the Guild did the Monthly Lotto Blocks, one quilter won all the blocks submitted by a drawing. With the Calendar Quilt, quilters who show their completed Calendar Block for that month will be entered into a drawing for a "door prize."

Annual Monetary Charity Donation

Ouilt show donations were \$352.80 each to the Hancock County Animal Shelter and the Ladies of Liberty of Slidell. In 2024 the same amount will be distributed to qualifying charities. We collected \$235 at the Christmas party for the Hancock County Food Pantry.

Charity Donation Chairperson

Louise H is the Charity Donation Chairperson to support our Guild. Please see Louise for labels for Charity Quilts. Louise read a thank you note received from the Armed Forces Retirement Home. She currently has 2 completed quilts and one that needs to be quilted for the Home. She also has a lapsized girl's quilt donated by Sue C. Louise is in the process of looking into a homeless shelter for teen girls in Slidell as a possible outlet for charity quilts.

UFOs (Unfinished Objects)

April H is our UFO master. She distributed a form for the UFO submission list, also previously sent to members via email. The list must be submitted to April by the February Business Meeting. Projects **must** be started to qualify, but guild projects and Sew 'N Draws from 2024 can be added. As members present their Show and Tell quilts/projects, April checks off any quilt/project on the member's UFO list. Members who complete UFO quilts/projects will be entered for a prize in a drawing at the Christmas party.

Quilt Show Director for 2025 Quilt Show

Sue C has graciously volunteered to be our Quilt Show Director for the Guild's 2025 Quilt Show. We must all help Sue to put on our best Quilt Show ever! Sue expressed that all members must enter one quilt into the Quilt Show and volunteer to help in whatever job capacity they can fulfill.

2025 Opportunity Quilt

April H has designed the Opportunity Quilt for the 2025 Quilt Show. April will coordinate construction of the Quilt. All members will be expected to work on the Opportunity Quilt in some capacity. The quilt is queen-sized. April wants to have the quilt finished

by the July 2024 GSQA meeting. We will be able to display the quilt there and sell tickets.

April will provide a sort of "road map" of the quilt top, sketching it out with block lines drawn in and dimensions.

February Program Meeting

The Program Meeting on February 22nd will be devoted to working on the 2025 Opportunity Quilt. Members will work on portions of the Opportunity Quilt as directed by Chair April H. April will let members know what to bring and have members join teams in order to work on the

Opportunity Quilt.

Sew 'N Draw

Michele M announced that the next Sew 'N Draw will be Saturday, February 17th, in the Kiln Library Meeting Room from 9am - 3pm. The pattern is Shuttered, a freebie from the Fat Quarter Shop, using Mardi Gras colors with a white background. Michele will provide information on how much fabric to bring at the February Business Meeting. It can be Mardi Gras colors or MG fabric. Future Sew 'N Draws will be in May, July, and September.

GSQA Traveling Teacher

Cindy Grisdela will hold a class on Monday, January 22, 2024, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm for Improv Puzzle Blocks. Marsha R took \$25 deposits at the July 13th Business Meeting with a total cost of \$60 for GSQA members: \$30 extra for nonmembers. We will need 20 participants to have the class. At present, we have 18 members signed up. We opened enrollment to local guilds after the September Business Meeting. The deposit was paid to hold our contract for Monday, January 22, 2024. Marsha has set up the class to be at the Coast Electric Building, HWY 49, Gulfport. A supply list was attached to the June Business Meeting Minutes and will go out again closer to the day of the class.

St. Joseph Abbey Retreat

The St. Joseph Abbey Retreat will be **March 5-8**, **2024**. The cost of the 3 1/2-day retreat is \$475.50 for overnight stay and meals; or \$65 daily rate to attend without overnight stay and 3 meals. Michele M is currently signing up Bay Oaks members. We need a minimum of 15 for the retreat. There are 8 quilters lined up who are not Guild members, so the retreat should be a go.

GSQA Rosebud Luncheon/Auction

The GSQA Rosebud Luncheon/Auction will be held on **April 6, 2024,** at Pinewood Plantation Country Club, 405 Country Club Blvd., Slidell, LA 70458. The Guild will provide 2 baskets for the luncheon/auction. Therese, Ida, and Sharon went to Willow Creek Quilt Shop in Vicksburg and purchased items for both baskets at the going-out-of-business sale. They spent \$39.78 for one and \$40.14

for the other. The pre-sale value was \$99.46 and \$115.86, so it was quite a bargain. If you have items to add to the baskets, please get them to Therese by January 26th, as she will deliver the baskets to the GSQA Meeting on the 27th.
