Change in By-Laws Creating Junior Membership Passes Unanimously

At the January 14th business meeting, the membership voted unanimously to create a Junior Membership category. Girls and boys, ages 15 years and younger, who show an interest in quilting can now join our guild if they are sponsored by an active guild member. Their annual dues are \$1.00. Junior membership entitles them to attend all guild meetings and classes, as long as they are accompanied by their sponsor. The same applies to the guild's classes being taught by GSQA Circuit Teachers and/or other instructors. Junior members are not permitted to vote on any guild business. On Saturday February 27th Therese will teach the German Chicken Catch-All Bag class from 9am – 3 pm at the Kiln Library meeting room.

Supply List

Two (2)	2" strips by width of fabric of 2 different fabrics. If you are using fat quarters, cut four (4) strips
	of each. If you are using fat quarters, you will be able to make two (2) chickens but you may
	need to reverse the fabric on the top and bottom on the second one.

One (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ square for tail

One (1) 3 ½" square for accent on tail (optional)

One (1) 2" square for beak One (1) 3 ½" square for comb Two (2) 9 ½" squares of lining

One (1) 7" zipper to match the top half of the chicken and thread to match that fabric

Two (2) small buttons for eyes (optional) You can draw eyes or embroider them.

Sewing machine, zipper foot, zig-zag foot, and basic sewing kit for machine sewing.

Before class, cut the 2" strips into smaller pieces. LABEL EACH!

For the top half of chicken cut: (2) 2" x 8"

(2) 2" x 6 ½"

(2) 2" x 5"

(2) 2" x 3 ½"

(2) 2" squares

For bottom half of chicken cut: (2) 2" x 9 ½"

(2) 2" x 8"

(2) 2" x 6 ½"

(2) 2" x 5"

(2) 2" x 3 ½"

(2) 2" squares
