Business Meeting March 10<sup>th</sup>

Program Night—March 24 th Gloria B will teach machine quilting. Here's her message:

"You can quilt your own quilts on your domestic machines. I will demo using a walking foot and free motion to quilt Bring the below items and I will help you to achieve your goal of finishing your own quilts.

- 1. Your cleaned machine with your instruction book. Bring your add -on table or the shelf that came with the machine.
- 2. A supply of needles, Microtex Sharp size 75/11 or 80/12
- 3. Thread: cotton size 50. Some brands that work well are Aurifil and Connecting Threads but if another brand works in your machine then use it. Contrasting color to your layered piece.
- 4. A walking foot and darning foot that works on your machine
- 5. A quilt sandwich at least 12" to 18" square or bigger to practice on. This should be pined together, 3" to 4" apart....not stitched. It doesn't have to be a patchwork piece but any fabric layered. Plain fabric will show your stitches which will help in the learning process.
- 6. Bring any aids that you use so we can learn from each other."

## **JOY Quilt Auction**

The annual JOY Quilt Auction will be held on Wednesday, March 9th at the Lamb of God Lutheran Church at 57210 Allen Road, Slidell, LA 70461 (take Fremaux exit off I-10 and go east, away from the new mall).
