- 1. Draw the name of your country (keep it to yourself).
- 2. Find the colors of the flag for your chosen country.
- 3. Make a quilt using those colors somewhere on your quilt.
- 4. Your quilt must show a representation of your country.
- 5. Quilt can be any size.
- 6. In addition to your flag colors, you can use any number of colors or fabrics.
- 7. DUE: Christmas party (at least the top if you haven't completed the entire project).

8. Keep your country a secret as we will have a guessing game at the party.

You can still participate. You can ask Therese and "draw" a country from the hat.
