  - 2. June teal, aqua, turquoise, sea blue, blue green, green blue whatever you want to call it!
  - 3. July red, white & blue
  - 4. August purple
  - 5. September yellow
  - 6. October brown
  - 7. November fall fabrics
  - 8. December Christmas fabrics
- 2. <u>UFO Challenge</u>: Everyone should have their UFO list in to Therese. We've already had a couple of projects completed.
