Project Night – May 22 – Color Workshop for Quilters

Violette Newby Abuya will teach us how to develop fabric into appliqués, such as the "fish" she created in the Opportunity Quilt. We will explore how to alter an existing fabric to suit your design purposes, as well as how to start from a blank piece of fabric in developing a design that pleases you. We will learn how to apply color through the use of pencils, markers, watercolors, and gel pens. Come prepared to have fun as we learn together !!

Supplies: fabric – plain muslin is fine
Pattern – something that is interesting to you – bird, fish, animal
Possible fabrics you have considered using
PENCIL – mechanical ones are best
Gel pens, sharpie markers, water color paint – whatever you have
Prisma color brand pencil set (if desired) (found at Michaels)
Scissors, needle and thread (if desired)
