7/8 yard Fabric for pillow body 3/8 yard of contrasting fabric for pillow band Sewing machine, matching thread, scissors, etc.

Preparation before coming to class:

- 1) from 7/8 yard pillow body fabric cut: 1 x 26 ½" x 41" rectangle
- 2) from 3/8 yard pillow band fabric cut: 1 x 10" x 41" strip
