As of 06/01/10 the Guild's Income of \$175 was realized from card sales, dues, and a refund of our deposit on DHCC. Disbursements of \$500 went to charitable contributions. #### Did You Know?

To wash small pieces of fabric without fraying the edges, put them in a salad spinner, rather than a washing machine. Spin with hot water and soap. Rinse in cool water, drain, and spin. Press the pieces dry.
