Quilt Show Revenue - Charitable Contribution Form

Fat Quarter Challenge 2015

At the last business meeting we announced a Fat Quarter Challenge. Those who were present at the meeting received paper bags containing 18 fat quarters. Some members also took bags for those who were not at the meeting. See Kay if you would like to participate.

Challenge Rules:

- 1. Each bag contains 18 fat quarters. The bags are opaque and stapled shut, so you have no idea what you are receiving. You may swap bags with someone else, but not individual fabrics.
- 2. You must use some of each fabric in your quilt. You do not have to use all the yardage, just some of each fabric.
- 3. You may use **one or two additional fabrics** in your quilt. You can use as much of these two additional fabrics as you wish; **you are not limited to a fat quarter of each additional fabric.**
- 4. The quilt may be any size and any type.
- 5. The completed **top** is due at the 2015 Christmas party. It does not have to be quilted.

For those of you who have no idea what to do with your fat quarters, we'll soon have a program with suggestions on how to use these random fabrics.

June 25 Project Night

Okay, So Now I Have All These Fat Quarters- What Do I Make?

We've all been there- in a quilt shop, eyeing the fat quarter display, unable to resist picking up two or three or ten. Before you know it, you're home alone with your stash wondering how to make all these fabrics play well together in a quilt.

Or maybe your guild has dumped lots of random fat quarters in your lap and challenged you to make a quilt using some of each fabric. It could happen.... What now?

June 25 four of our members will give us ideas on what to do with these fat quarters. We'll learn what patterns work well with fat quarters and how adding one or two fabrics to the mix can open up lots of possibilities.

Bay Oaks Retreat

Bay Oaks is in the process of scheduling its first ever retreat at Beckwith Plantation for 2016. Current plans call for a Thursday - Sunday retreat. Cost is \$99 per person per night for double occupancy plus \$20 per person for breakfast and lunch on the departing day. (\$317 for the entire weekend) There is a required 15 person minimum for **each day** covered by the contract. Given that the guild is required to place a \$800 deposit, we'd like each member to seriously consider if this is something they would like to do in August of 2016.

Melinda Bula - Quilt and Fiber Artist

Bay Oaks will sponsor a 2 day class with Melinda Bula, January 21-22, 2016. Learn how to layer fabric colors and use thread painting to create a beautiful floral quilt or wall hanging. Check out her blog melindabula.blogspot.com

Tip of the Month

- To get a perfect ¼ " seam allowance, use both a ¼" foot AND mark the ¼" in front of the right feed dog with tape. (Alex Anderson)
- Test your 1/4" seam allowance by sewing two 11/4" wide strips together and pressing the seam.
 Measure across the joined strips. If the piece measures 2" you are tight on the money. If not, adjust your seam width and try again.
