SUPPLY LIST

¼ yard (42" washed) each of 12 fabrics: 3 darks, 3 mediums, 3 light mediums, and 3 lights

fabric selection: you can choose 12 of the same color; 6 from one color and 6 from a complimentary color; choose 9 from one color and 3 from another color; or

choose 12 different colors, BUT, the biggest thing is to make sure the 12 fabrics spread across the spectrum from very dark to very light (see in-person example)

cutting instructions: from each of the 12 fabrics, cut three 2 ½" strips (width of fabric), so, when you're done cutting, you'll have three strips of each fabric which are 2 ½" x 42"

Bring your machine and the usual supplies for machine sewing
