Bay Oaks is in the process of scheduling its first ever retreat at Beckwith Plantation for 2016. Current plans call for a Thursday - Sunday retreat. (\$317 for the entire weekend) There is a required 15 person minimum for **each day** covered by the contract. - so often, clean lint from behind the blade of your rotary cutter, and lubricate the blade with a drop of sewing machine oil to keep it rolling smoothly. Shoot digital photos the first time you take the cutter apart so you can always get the cutter back together correctly.
