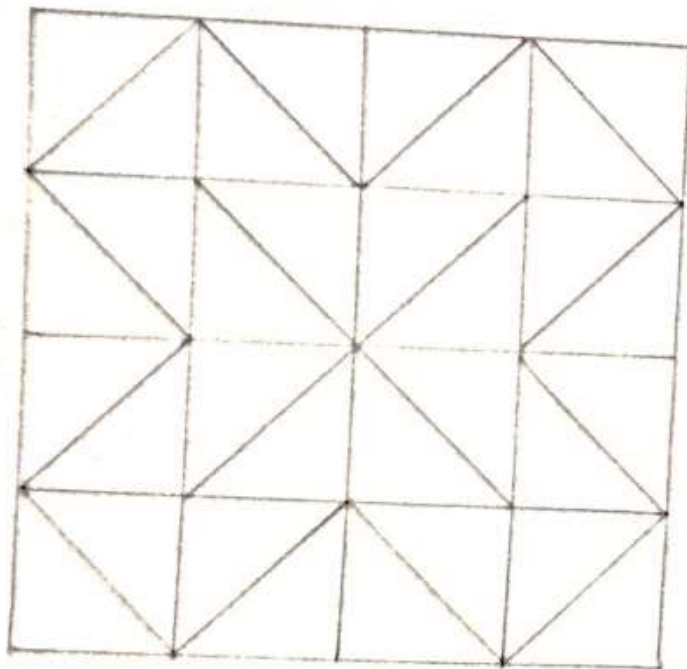

Block of the Month Due July 11



Is your block of the month done? Despite the grayscale picture at left, colors are "Sewer's choice".

The block is a 12" pieced star. To make your half-square triangles (HSTs), you'll want to start with 4" squares, make your diagonal line and then sew a seam $\frac{1}{4}$ " from line on each side and cut into HSTs. Trim each HST down to 3-1/2". One suggestion would be to make 2 HSTs from dark and light fabric combinations, and 6 HSTs from medium and light fabric (see below):
