# <u>Bay Oaks Schedules Michael Young Circuit Teacher Class- Who's</u> Afraid of Y Seams?

GSQA Circuit Teacher, Michael Young, will present his Y-seam class on Saturday, September  $15^{th}$  at the Kiln Library from 9:30-3:00. Before the age of rotary cutters, quilters designed some of the most beautiful blocks around and a lot of them contained the Y" seam. With the development of rotary cutting methods and the desire to make everything simple, "Y" seams went the way of the dinosaur. This class will help take the fear out

of constructing blocks that our fore-quilters had no problems with. Blocks like the Baton Rouge block and other "Y" seam blocks will start appearing in your quilts after you learn how easy "Y" seams really are. Sign-ups for this class will start at the August business meeting. Registration is \$10 for Bay Oaks/GSQA members and \$20 for Bay Oaks members who do not belong to GSQA. Besides sewing machine and basic quilting supplies, each student will need to bring four half-yard cuts of fabric- one very light value, one very dark value, and two medium values (one can be the focus fabric and one can be a zinger.)

#### **Mystery Quilt Errata**

There is a mistake in the yardage listed for the neutral fabric in the mystery quilt supply list. It should read 2 3/4 yard of fabric. This is a yard more than the original instructions.

Directions for Step #1 of the Mystery are included at the end of the newsletter.

### Errata for May 2012 Row Quilt Block- Spring Basket

There is an error in the directions for cutting Triangle Insets (E). The First Method directions say to cut four 7 ½" squares and then to subcut them diagonally in both directions.

Instead, cut seven 7 ½" squares. Next cut those squares in half diagonally <u>only once.</u> This will yield the 14 setting triangles needed for the blocks.
