August Project Night – August 27

Margaret Jankowski of *The SEWING MACHINE PROJECT* will be our guest speaker. Anyone wishing to donate a sewing machine may bring it to the meeting that night. Kay will take them to the collection center at **All Brands** in Baton Rouge. Anyone interested in sewing and members of other guilds are welcome to attend.

The Sewing Machine Project began in 2005 in response to the devastating tsunami in Southeast Asia. Margaret began collecting sewing machines in her local city of Madison, Wisconsin, to send them to those in need. The response was overwhelming—sewing machines and supplies poured in. After sending 25 sewing machines to the affected areas of Sri Lanka and India, disaster struck closer to home.

Hurricane Katrina struck in August 2005 only three weeks after Margaret had been in New Orleans for a sewing conference. Margaret decided to shift her efforts to serve the greater New Orleans area. Initially serving individuals and expanding to serve schools and community groups, the **Sewing Machine Project**, to date, has delivered over 800 sewing machines to New Orleans.

Today the Sewing Machine Project works locally, nationally and internationally, striving to build and strengthen community through sewing. They have delivered over 1800 sewing machines overall. (See the The SEWING MACHINE PROJECT attachment for more information.)
