In-House Classes At our September 25th meeting Melba LaCaze will demonstrate a shawl or placemats using strips and special stitches for accent. You will need your sewing machine and associated supplies plus the below materials.

MATERIALS FOR SHAWL

18" X 80" in length

Base: 8 assorted fat quarters Embellishment: 5 assorted fat quarters Binding: 1 fat quarter or ½ yard

Sewing with batiks use #70/10 sharp machine needle

Sewing with other cottons use #80/12 sharp machine needle

To make 6 placemats same as above but 2 FQ's for binding or 3/4 yard

Ugly Fabric Challenge. Rules are as follows:

- Keep your quilt design or layout a secret! Do not show or tell any other guild member until the 1. showing at the Christmas party.
- The ugly fabric must be prominent and the most visible piece that catches your eye. 2.
- Your quilt should be between 72" and 96" around the perimeter in any shape you choose. 3.
- 4. Your quilt must be completed, quilted and bound by the Christmas Party.
- Use no more than four (4) other fabrics and any design you wish. 5.
- You must label and name your quilt. 6.
- 7. Do not make a Christmas quilt.

At our September business meeting we will be putting together the rest of the rolled fabric for a contribution to MOA. Our many thanks to those who signed up to cook for our Friday night meal.

We would very much like to fill the other 8 spots so feel free to ask your friends from other guilds to join us. While on retreat Solveig will give us a demonstration. This is the list of supplies you will need to make the Foux Stained Glass Quilt.

- Six or nine different fabrics that go together and also contrast. If six, have enough to make nine 1 squares or rectangles
- Thin fabric for the foundation
- Bias tape 1/4"/ribbon/ home made bias tape 3
- 4 Glue stick
- 5 Thread to match bias/ribbon
