<u>Bay Oaks Schedules Michael Young Circuit Teacher Class-Who's Afraid of Y Seams?</u>


GSQA Circuit Teacher, Michael Young, will present his Y-seam class on Saturday, September 15th at the Kiln Library from 9:30 – 3:00.

- Four half-yard cuts of fabric- one very light value, one very dark value, two medium values (one can be the focus fabric and one can be a zinger.
- Sewing machine and basic quilting supplies.

Mystery Quilt, Step #2 Directions

Step 1:

Cut sixteen 3 ½" squares from your PRINT fabric Cut eight 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles from your DARK fabric.

Mark diagonal lines on the back of your 3 ½" squares. Place these squares right sides together at each end of your DARK rectangles. Sew just outside the diagonal line and press to the corner. Makes eight flying geese.

Step 2:

Cut sixteen 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles from the DARK.
Cut thirty-two 3 ½" squares from the NEUTRAL fabric.

Following directions in Step 1, make sixteen flying geese units.

<u>Step 3:</u>

This step will make part of the border. If you are worried about having enough neutral fabric or you wish to wait and see what you want as a border, you do not have to do this step now.

Cut thirty-six 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles of your MEDIUM fabric.

Cut seventy-two 3 ½" squares from your NEUTRAL fabric.

Again, following the directions of step 1, create thirty-six flying geese units in the MEDIUM and NEUTRAL color ways.
