Proposal to amend Bylaws

<u>Current Bylaw regarding expenditures:</u> Any expenditure of \$.01 to \$99.99 requires prior approval from the Treasurer and President of the Guild. Expenditures of \$100 or more require prior Executive Board approval.

<u>Bylaw amendment:</u> Add to last sentence "... And the majority of the members attending the next business meeting."

<u>Reason for amendment:</u> The Board has been working under the presumption that the membership was required to approve all expenditures of \$100 or more, based on current practice. This amendment to the bylaws would prescribe the current practice.
