### **Treasurer's Report**

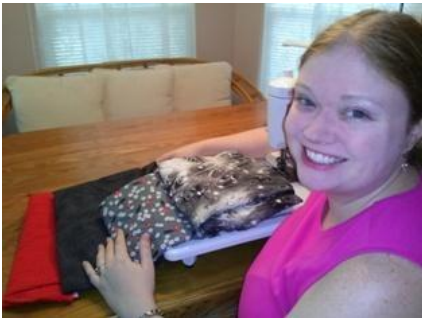
