Block of the Month

Proposal to amend Bylaws - We will be voting on the Bylaw proposal at the October business meeting.

Current Bylaw regarding expenditures: Any expenditure of \$.01 to \$99.99 requires prior approval from the Treasurer and President of the Guild. Expenditures of \$100 or more require prior Executive Board approval.

Bylaw amendment: Add to last sentence "... And the majority of the members attending the next business meeting."

Reason for amendment: The Board has been working under the presumption that the membership was required to approve all expenditures of \$100 or more, based on current practice. This amendment to the bylaws would prescribe the current practice.
