

Ne get to start piecers!! First however you must cut 24 2 inch squares of BOTH your light & Medium!

All blocks should squared up to 6-1/2".

Step	Directions			
1	Attach 2"x3-1/2" Medium with Neutral corners Geese to the Dark ones of the same size as shown. Press toward blunt end of Goose. Square up to 3-1/2". (Diagram 4.1) THESE ARE FROM PARTITIES.			
2	Join 2 Double Geese from step#1 together as showncreating 2 units. Press toward blunt end of Goose. Then join these 2 units together to create Block#9 . (Diagram 4.2)			
3	Attach a 2" square of Neutral to 24 of the 2" HSTs. Press toward Neutral. Attach a 2" square of Medium to the other 24 2" HSTs. Press toward Medium. Join two units together as shown. Press toward all Medium side. Square up to 3 1/2". (Diagram 4.3)			
4	Attach each unit from step#3 to a 4-patch unit. Press toward the 4-Patch unit Then join 2 units together to create 12 of Block#8 . (Diagram 4.4)			
5	Using all the 3-1/2"x6-1/2" Geese of Dark with Neutral Corners, join 2 together, pressing toward blunt end of Goose, to create 8 of Block#7. (Diagram 4.5)			

Using all the 3-1/2"x6-1/2" Geese of Dark with Print Corners, join 2 together, pressing toward blunt end of Goose, to create 4 of Block#6. (Diagram 4.6)

Weekend Whatever#6 - Directions: Part#5

This step will finish the blocks...I challenge you to figure out how it's all going to go together! Be very careful to watch the graphics in this part...you will be making mirror images of a couple of blocks.

Remember...all blocks are to be squared up to 6-1/2".

Step	Directions			
1	Attach 8 units from Part#1-step#3 to $5"\times6-1/2"$ rectangles of Printwatching the orientation carefullypressing toward solid Printto create 8 of Block#5 . (Diagram 5.1)			
2	Attach the other 8 units from Part#1-step#3 to 5"x6-1/2" rectangles of Printwatching the orientation carefullypressing toward solid Printto create 8 of Block#4 . (Diagram 5.2)			
3	Attach a 2"x6-1/2" rectangle of Neutral to a 5"x6-1/2" rectangle of Print. Press toward Neutralcreating 2 of Block#3 . (Diagram 5.3)			
4	Using 80 3-1/2" squares units from Part#1-step#2: join 2 units together as shown, pressing toward solid edge. (Diagram 5.4)			
5	Using the other 80 3-1/2" squares units from Part#1-step#2: join 2 units together as shown, pressing toward solid edge. (Diagram 5.5)			
6	Using 20 of each unit from steps#4 & 5join together as shown to create 20 of Block#2 . (Diagram 5.6)			
7	Using 20 of each unit from steps#4 & 5join together as shown to create 20
