Marge's Mystery - Directions: Part#6

Note: the non-pieced graphics showing the Print fabric are your 6-1/2" squares.

Step	Directions
	Quilt Center
1	Create 2 of each row as shown, pressing each rows seams in as they will go. Then join the rows together to create 2 of Corner A . Note: this corner uses Block#1 for lacework. (Diagram 6.1)
2	Create 2 of each row as shown, pressing each rows seams in as they will go. Then join the rows together to create 2 of Corner B . Note: this corner uses Block#2 for lacework. (Diagram 6.2)
3	Create 2 of Row#1 as shownagain, pressing seams as they will go. (Diagram 6.3)
4	Create 2 of Row#2 as shownagain, pressing seams as they will go. (Diagram 6.4)
5	Attach Corner A and Corner B to opposite sides of Row#2press seams toward Corners. (Diagram 6.5)
6	Attach Row#1 to opposite sides of Block#9 (Diagram 6.6)
7	Attach units from step#5 to opposite sides of unit from step#7 to complete the center of the top. (Diagram 6.7)
	Borders
8	Attach a 3-1/2" HST to opposite sides of a 3-1/2" squares of Print, pressing toward printcreating 4 units. (Diagram 6.8)
9	Attach 4 of the last Geese together as showncreating 4 units. (Diagram 6.9)
10	Attach 5 of the Geese together as showncreating 4 units. (Diagram 6.10)

11	Attach a 3-1/2" square of Neutral to the right of 2 units from step#9attach a 3-1/2" square of Neutral to the other 2 units from step#9press toward Neutral square. (Diagram 6.11)
12	Attach a right unit and a left unit from step#11 to either side of HST units from step#8. (Diagram 6.12)
13	Attach a unit from step#10 to either side of last HST units from step#8. (Diagram 6.13)
14	Using 2" strips of Darkmake 2 of 2"x66-1/2" and attach to long sides. Then make 2 of 2"x57-1/2" and attach to ends. (Diagram 6.14)
15	Attach a unit from step#13 to long sides of top. (Diagram 6.15)
16	Attach a unit from step#12 to ends of top. (Diagram 6.15)
17	Using 2" strips of Darkmake 2 of 2"x75-1/2" and attach to long sides. Then make 2 of 2"x63-1/2" and attach to ends. (Diagram 6.16)









