

## Hot Chocolate

1. Follow directions for your fusible - they come with the fusible
2. Trace shapes onto the paper side of your fusible. The shapes are reversed for machine applique. Cut shapes out leaving a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " or so border from the cutting edge. Place fusible on WRONG side of fabric and press to fuse to the fabric of choice. Cut out the pieces on the cutting line and set aside
3. Cut background 13" square. Winner of blocks can trim up blocks to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ "
4. Lay out your pieces, (after peeling the paper backing off), layering the from back to front. Bottom of mug goes over the middle of the mug - about  $\frac{1}{8}$ ", cup handle tucks under side of mug. cup rim goes over bottom of marshmallows.
5. Center as best you can. The steam gets tucked under the <sup>top</sup> marshmallows or if you are embroidering the steam start looking at top of the marshmallows and start stitching.
