## ABOUT THIS SERIES QUILT

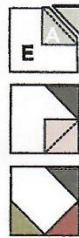
*Warmth of Our Stars* is a series quilt presented in six parts. Part One appeared in *Love of Quilting's* January/February 2021 issue, and included materials and cutting instructions for all six parts. In Part Three you'll make Scott's Dancing Stars blocks, which will surround the Center Section with a twinkling of colors!

Scott Flanagan, a master designer and teacher of serialized quilts, designed this quilt and came in to our studios to teach the lessons associated with each installment, as well as special tips and tricks for working with flannel and 2½" strip sets! ## DANCING STARS ASSEMBLY

Use an accurate ¼" seam allowance throughout to ensure all elements of the quilt fit together well. To achieve Scott's scrappy look, randomly select assorted color patches.

1. Place assorted color A on white tonal E, right sides facing. Sew diagonally as shown in *Diagram VIII*. Trim ¼" beyond stitching as shown. Press open. Repeat on 2 adjacent corners of white E to make unit 4. Make 16 total.

2. Referring to *Diagram IX*, place assorted color A on white B, right sides facing. Sew diagonally; trim ¼" beyond stitching. Press open. Repeat on opposite end of white B to make Flying Geese 2. Make 32 total.

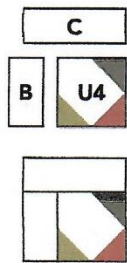
3. Referring to *Diagram X*, lay out 2 white A's and 2 assorted color A's. Join as shown to make Four-Patch. Make 16 total.

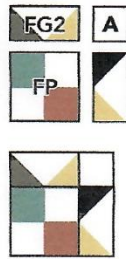


4. Join 1 white B, 1 white C, and 1 unit 4 to complete section 4 (Diagram XI). Make 16 total.



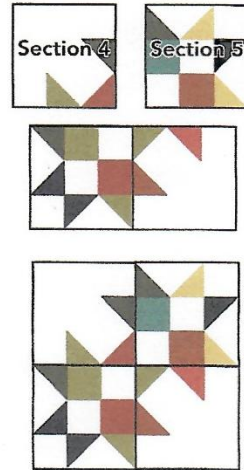
Section 4

5. Lay out 1 white A, 2 Flying Geese 2's, and 1 Four-Patch as shown in Diagram XII. Join to complete section 5. Make 16 total.

6. Noting orientation, join 2 section 4's and 2 section 5's to complete block W (Diagram XIII). Make 8 total.
