

# Casserole Carrier

Two 20", 22", or 24" Sq blocks, pieced or solid

One 20", 22", or 24" Sq Batting

One 26" x 5" strip of fabric for handle

One 26" x 5" strip of interfacing if using thin fabric

92" to 108" binding

2 rings, can use macrame rings, large key rings, plastic bangles, ponytail holders, or make some with fabric.

## Casserole Carrier

1. Quilt a 22" by 22" block and bind. This can be pieced or can be one piece of fabric for each side.
2. Handle: 26" by 5" same as block or matching fabric. Interface if light weight fabric. Fold in half lengthwise and fold the edges to the center. Top stitch.
3. Place this handle on the inside of the block from one corner to the opposite corner. Turn under the ends and stitch and double stitch. This will carry the weight of the casserole.
4. Rings: [REDACTED]. On the same side as the handle, attach the rings to the other two corners by bringing the corner through the ring and double stitch.
