

How to create Color Challenge Art Piece

(Charlotte's Method)

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1. Pick your color page.



2. Decide your idea or subject. Find a photo online or use your own photo to make a pattern.



3. Print your photograph in grayscale to make your pattern. Scale your photo to the size you want before you print. (I use Powerpoint where a 16 x 20 picture would print in 4 pages once you scale the picture)



4. Tape the 4 pages together to create your pattern.

5. Place waxpaper or tracing paper over the printed grayscale and trace to make a line drawing.



6. Place a scrap piece of white or muslin on top of line drawing and draw outline using water soluble ink marker. (This will serve as your backing to place your fabric pieces)

7. Pick scraps matching your tones.



8. Iron Lite Heatbond or any adhesive of your choice on fabric. (I cut strips big enough for sections. If I have leftovers, I keep it for other projects.)



9. Using a lightbox, trace each section of your image on fabric and iron onto background.

10. After covering each pattern piece on backing, quilt and add embellishment as desired.
