Fabrics Needed: (**Please only use pre-washed fabric!**)

You provide a Christmas PRINT/STRIPE fabric as the "wrapping paper".

matching both "ribbon" fabric and the "bow" fabric mental states

Cutting Directions:

To coordinate with your "gift wrap."

"wrapping paper" fabric:

Cut (3) 3 1/2" x 5" rectangles

Cut (1) 3 %" x 3 %" square

Cut (1) 2" x 3 1/2" rectangle

Cut (1) 1 $3/8" \times 1 3/8"$ square (draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of this square)

"ribbon" fabric (****):

Cut (4) 2" x 3 %" rectangles

Cut (3) 1 3/8" x 1 3/8" squares (draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square)

"bow" fabric ():

Cut (4) 2" x 2" squares


Cut (4) 1 3/8" x 1 3/8" squares (draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square)

Sewing Directions: (ANOTE Figures 1, 2, and 3 are not shown oriented as they will be in the block.)

Set aside the 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ square and (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 5" rectangles of the disk wrapping paper fabric for now. Take (3) of the seel bow fabric 2" squares and sew a state ribbon fabric 1 3/8" square to the bottom right corner, being sure to orient the diagonal line as shown in Fig. 1. Take (1) of the bow fabric 2" squares and sew a wrapping paper fabric 13/8" square to the bottom right corner, being sure to orient the Fig. 1 diagonal line as shown in Fig. 1. Take (2) white ribbon fabric 2" x 3 ½" rectangles and sew a 1 3/8" will bow fabric square to the bottom right corner, being sure to orient the diagonal line as shown in Fig. 2. Take (1) wrapping paper fabric 2" x 3 ½" rectangle and sew a 1 3/8" was bow fabric square to the bottom right corner, being sure to orient the diagonal line as shown in Fig. 2. Press each of the small triangles towards the corner and then trim the seam to %".

Lay out the pieces as shown below in Fig. 4. Sew together the units in 3 vertical columns. Press seams as shown by the arrows. Sew columns together, matching seams. Press seams as shown by the arrows. Your completed square should measure 9 ½" (unfinished size). DO NOT TRIM BLOCK.
