## ABOUT THIS SERIES QUILT

*Warmth of Our Stars* is a series quilt presented in six parts. Part One appeared in *Love of Quilting's* January/February 2021 issue, and included materials and cutting instructions for all six parts. In Part Four you'll build some cozy Log Cabin blocks, which will become the vibrant frame you see on Scott's quilt.

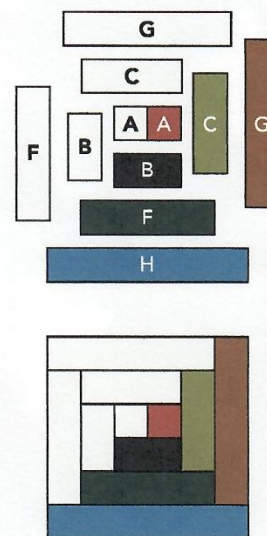
Scott Flanagan, a master designer and teacher of serialized quilts, designed this quilt and came in to our studios to teach the lessons associated with each installment, as well as special tips and tricks for working with flannel and 2½" strip sets! ## LOG CABIN AND SIDE UNIT ASSEMBLY

Use an accurate ¼" seam allowance throughout to ensure all elements of the quilt fit together well. To achieve Scott's scrappy look, randomly select assorted color patches.

### BLOCK X ASSEMBLY

1. Referring to *Diagram XIV*, lay out 1 each white A, assorted color A, white B, assorted color B, white C, assorted color C, white F, assorted color F, white G, assorted color G, plus 1 assorted color H as shown.
2. Join white A and assorted color A. Continue to add patches alphabetically in a clockwise direction to complete block X. Make 12 total. Set 4 block X's aside for corner unit assembly.

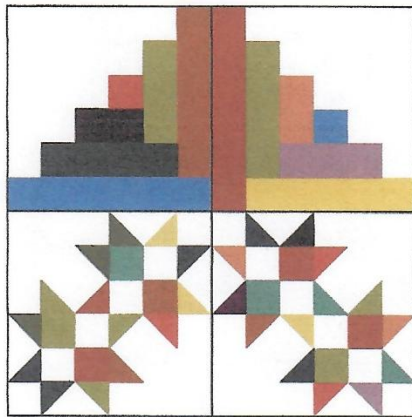
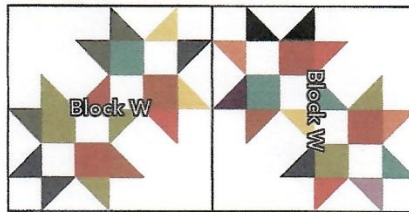
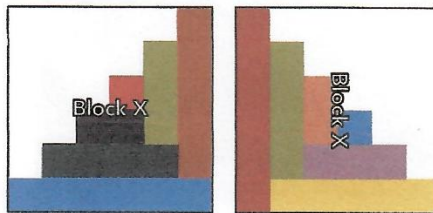


Block X

**SIDE UNIT ASSEMBLY**

1. Referring to *Diagram XIV*, and noting orientations, lay out 2 block W's and 2 block X's as shown.
2. Join blocks into rows; join rows to complete side unit. Make 4 total.
