# **September Program Meeting**



The Program for September will be held on the 22nd.

Chris Jarrell will be showing you how to make her Mat & Ruler Bag. If you would like to make this

project along with her demonstration you will need the following materials:

- ·2 yards of quilted fabric off the bolt is easiest, but you can make the quilted fabric using your own 2 fabrics and batting. Be sure the front and back of the fabrics you buy or make are coordinated cotton fabric and the grid lines are no more than 1 ½" apart.
- $\cdot 4 \frac{1}{2}$  yards of  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " wide webbing for handles.
- · Thread to match fabrics

Supplies to get the job done....

- · Cutting mat, rotary cutter & rulers
- ·Sewing machine and all that goes with that.

Instructions will be given out at the meeting. There are 3 photos of the project, 1 of the outside and 2 of the inside of the Mat & Ruler Bag. If you have any questions before the meeting, please call Chris – 228-342-1179.
