**August 24 Program**: Presented by Sharon Barnes. Assembled the donated blocks from our GSQA meeting into 6 quilt tops. Members used fabrics suitable for red/white/blue sashing. April Holifield suggested showing the quilts to the GSQA

members at their October Meeting. Their members donated the blocks when our Guild hosted the July, 2023, GSQA Meeting.

An email was sent out last week asking members to donate fabric at this Business Meeting to be used as backing for these quilts. The measurements are: 54 inches by 70 inches; 54 inches by 55 inches; and 55 inches by 70 inches. Marge Sandy will donate the batting for the quilts. Susan Luc and Louise Huye (she had it in her possession) will quilt one quilt top each. Kay Guillot volunteered to quilt the last 4 quilt tops.

**BOQG Website:** Kay Guilott reviewed the site and reported that it wasn't hard to use. She did some updates. Debbie Ludde made updates also. Debbie also got pricing on Wild Appricot's website packages. Rhonda McNaughton sent Debbie last year's renewal prices for GoDaddy. GoDaddy's pricing is lower. It was suggested that the members of BOQG make 2 quilts for the Vietnam Women Veteran's Inc.'s conference. It was brought up that the 6 quilts that were made might have incorrect dimensions for the Quilts of Valor. More information is needed to find out if the donated quilts were to be Quilts of Valor quilts. Louise Huye said she would follow up.
