August Program Meeting



Bountiful Blessings - Unit 1




Bountiful Blessings Unit 2 Half-Square Triangles - New Technique




Beautiful Blessings - Center Peel Back

The Lotto block for October is any pattern for a 12 ½ inch block with any Halloween colors and prints.




Halloween Lotto Block Example
